- 1. Project Name: Fairfax Bolinas Road MP 5.73 Slope Improvements
- 2. Project Location: Fairfax, Unincorporated Marin County
- 3. Project Description: This project involves the construction of 2 emergency retaining walls to be built in phases. Phase 1 will generally involve an 80 LF steel soldier pile retaining wall (shoring system) with steel plate or timber lagging to secure the westbound lane. Phase 2 will generally involve the construction of an approximately 165 LF concrete retaining wall, tiebacks may be required pending soil exploration, compacted fill materials using select imported structural backfill, & repaving approximately 225 feet of the eastbound lane of Fairfax Bolinas Road at Mile Post 5.73.
