- 1. Project Name: Sir Francis Drake Blvd Emergency Culvert and Ditch Cleaning
- **2. Project Location:** The project is located along Sir Francis Drake Boulevard at mile posts 25.44, 26.61, and 29.11 in Inverness, CA, Unincorporated Marin County.
- **3. Project Description:** Flooding occurred milepost marker 25.44, 26.61, and 29.11. The work will generally include removal of all loose sediment and vegetation at culvert inlets, outlets, and ditches. Lane closure with traffic control measures will be required.
