WHEREAS, in 2000, John was accepted into Canada's National Ballet School, under the direction of Mavis Staines, as one of the few North American recipients of a Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation scholarship; and

WHEREAS, upon graduation, John received the Peter Dwyer Scholarship Award for Remarkable Promise, the Lawrence Haskett Award, he joined the Boston Ballet II, under the direction of Mikko Nissinen, and was promoted to Corps De Ballet in 2004. His performances include *La Sylphide*, George Balanchine's *Divertimento No. 15*, Jiri Kylian's *Sarabande*, William Foryste's *In the middle, somewhat elevated* and John Cranko's *The Taming of the Shrew*; and

WHEREAS, in the past year, John was the only American male semifinalist in the Helsinki International Ballet Competition, a finalist in the Seoul International Ballet Competition, and was awarded a 2005 fellowship by the Princess Grace Foundation.
