## **RECOMMENDATION:**

- 2. Increase Revenue Account 4000053000-4530527 by \$49,980.00 in Fund 20900.
- 3. Increase Expense Account 4000053000-5210100 by \$45,040.00 in Fund 20900.
- 4. Increase Expense Account 4000053000-5110110 by \$4,940.00 in Fund 20900.

**SUMMARY:** On October 19, 2004, we presented a letter requesting your Board approve a our application for a Farm and Ranch Solid Waste Cleanup and Abatement Grants from the California Integrated Waste Management Board not to exceed \$50,000 per single cleanup or abatement project, with a limit of \$200,000 per fiscal year for a period not to exceed five fiscal years for each eligible Applicant. On November 14, 2005 the California Integrated Waste Management Board awarded a grant in the amount of \$49,980 to fund the cleanup and removal of up to 7,000 tires and approximately 80 cubic yards of debris from a site located on Williamsen Ranch property at 3599 Dillon Beach Road, Tomales, CA 94971.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** There is no net county cost. The funds required to cover the cost of this project will be fully supported by the grant monies.
