SUBJECT: Continuation of emergency declarations of conditions requiring slide repairs on Terrace Avenue in Bolinas and Redwood Avenue in Woodacre

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION: Continue the emergency declarations.

SUMMARY: On August 9 and 23, 2011, your Board adopted Resolution Nos. 2011-73 and 2011-80, respectively, declaring that emergencies exist on Terrace Avenue in Bolinas and on Redwood Avenue in Woodacre and authorizing contracting without going through full formal bidding pursuant to Section 22050 of the Public Contracts Code (PCC).

The resolutions set forth the necessary findings that emergency conditions exist. It also directed the Public Works Director to take all steps necessary to address the emergency conditions and to report back to your Board at every regularly scheduled meeting until the work is completed. Finally, the resolution language states that they remain effective until superseded by a subsequent resolution.

Construction repair work at Terrace Avenue and at Redwood Avenue is currently underway. Staff is continuing to move these projects forward on a priority basis in order to ensure completion of the work before the onset of winter rains. It is therefore recommended that your Board continue the emergency declarations.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no impact to the General Fund by this action. Appropriations for identified slide repair costs are budgeted in the Storm Damage Repair Special Project (10000-4100995057).
